

NOTICE OF MEETING

A meeting of the Nebraska Real Estate Commission will be held on September 27, 2013, in the Staybridge Room of the Staybridge Suites, located at 2701 Fletcher Avenue in Lincoln, Nebraska. The meeting will be convened at 9:00 a.m. on September 27, and will continue on that date until adjourned.

At 9:30 a.m. on September 27, 2013, the Commission will conduct a public hearing on the adoption of proposed amendments to Title 299, Chapters 7 & 9, relating to expiration dates for broker-approved training recognition and time-share exchange agent filings. The proposed amendments will provide that both the broker-approved training recognition and time-share exchange agent filings expire after 3 years.

All interested persons are invited to attend and testify at the hearing. Written comments may also be submitted, and will be made part of the hearing record at the time of the hearing if the comments are received on or before September 17, 2013. Testimony and/or comments will be limited to the proposed amendments to Title 299, Chapters 7 & 9. The regulatory change will have no fiscal impact to the Nebraska Real Estate Commission, the public, or regulated persons.
